### Welcome

### Facility Policies

- Here are some of the more important policies to be aware of while visiting the Campus Recreation facilities:
- Pets (other than service animals) are not permitted at outdoor fields, pool area, or indoor facilities.
- Alcohol is not permitted in any public area on campus (including parking lots), which includes all Campus Recreation indoor or outdoor facilities.
- Smoking or other tobacco products are not permitted at any Campus Recreation indoor or outdoor facilities.
- Food and Drinks (exception – re-sealable drink bottles) are not permitted in any indoor Campus Recreation facilities.
- Children must be supervised at all times while at any Campus Recreation facilities.
- Visiting teams/clubs/individuals are not permitted in activity areas other than the dedicated event location, with the exception of locker rooms.
- If a large group would like access to locker rooms and showers after an event, please notify our staff directly or through the host club prior to arriving on campus so we are prepared for a large group.
- Violators of any of the above policies or other Campus Recreation or Colorado State University policies will be asked to leave.
- In the event of non-compliance, University Police will be called.
- Visiting clubs/ individuals may be reported to their university administration or sport governing body for possible further review.

## Medical Services

We provide a Certified Athletic Trainer (ATC) for emergency coverage at these competitions: Men's Ice Hockey, Men's Lacrosse, Women's Lacrosse, Men's Rugby, and Women's Rugby.

The ATC is present for injury evaluation and emergencies only. Should your team need pre-game taping, you must contact the ERPS Coordinator 2 weeks in advance of the contest and your team would need to supply tape and other supplies.

For Women's Ice Hockey, Men's Soccer and Women's Soccer, we staff games with a student employee that is trained in first aid, CPR, and AED.

## Available Supplies

We can provide visiting teams with large water containers. Please email the ERPS Coordinator 1 week in advance of the contest in order to assure our staff is aware of the request.

Ice bags will be available to injured athletes.
